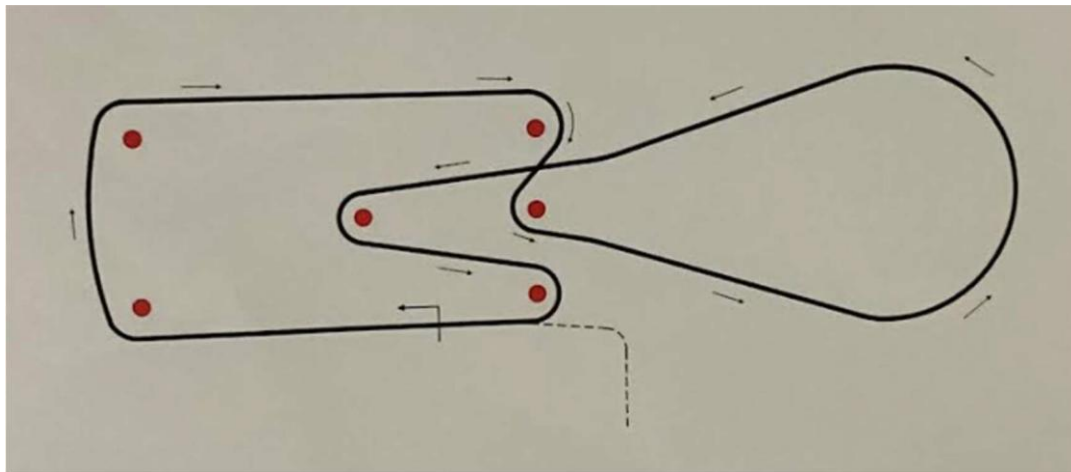
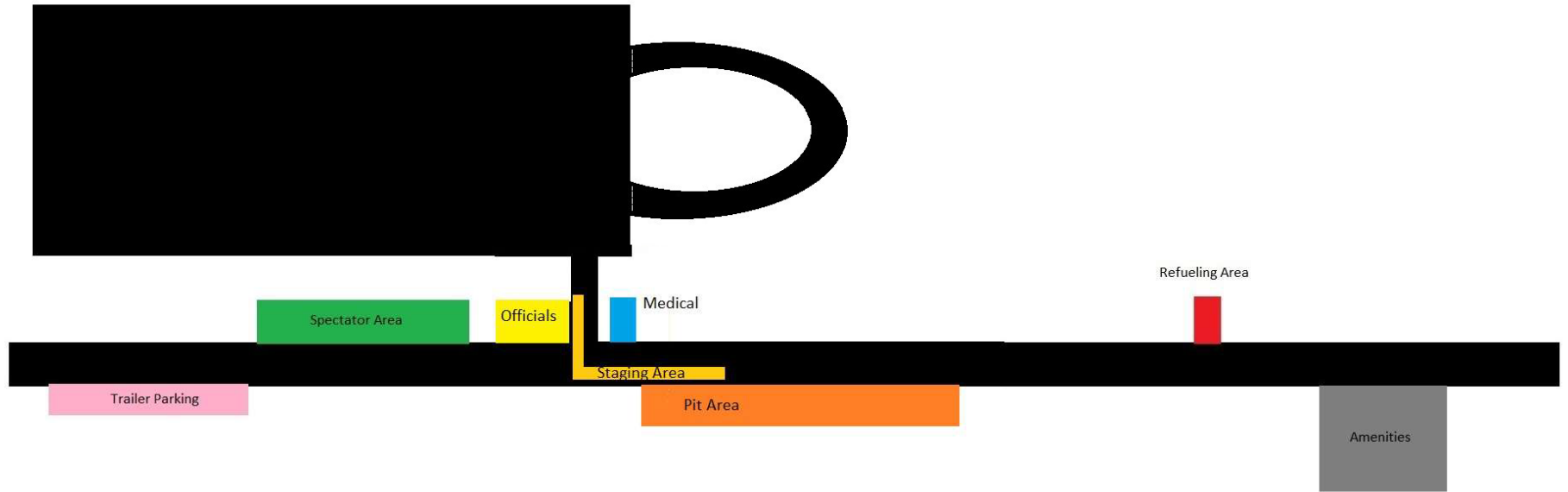
# Area Layout for Marque Sprint Events at LVMA
