# VEHICLE AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- Vehicles must comply with the AASA NCR's and the AASA Event Operations Manual.
- Vehicles must be competition ready with all loose items removed from the vehicle.

#### SCRUTINEERING

- No vehicle may be used for practice or competition until passed by the Chief Scrutineer, or by a Scrutineer delegated the task by the Chief Scrutineer.
- Scrutineering will be conducted on Friday night at Manton Park on the 13th of October, from 6.00pm. For competitors who are unable to make Friday night, scrutineering will also be held on Saturday morning of the event from 7.00am. Scrutiny will be as per section 9 of the AASA Event Operations Manual.
- Current competition licence and full driving apparel must be presented at scrutiny. If your vehicle has been issued with a Vehicle Passport, this must be presented at Scrutiny as well. Vehicles which suffer damage must be re-examined before entering the track again.
- Specific attention will be given to Harnesses, will be checked for condition plus how they are mounted.

- Fire extinguishers will be checked to make sure no extinguishers is outside of Australian standards and use by dates.
- Safety Requirements
  - (a) Approved non-flammable clothing and footwear, with clothing extending from ankles to neck and wrists;
  - (b) Safety helmet being those with the following markings:
    - i. AS1698 Australian Standard
    - ii. Snell SA95, M90, SA95, SA2000, SA2020 USA Standard
    - iii. SFI Spec 31.1, 31.2, 31.1A. 31.2A USA Standard
    - iv. E22 (with 03, 04 or 05 amendments) European Standard
    - v. BS 6658-85 Type A and A/FR British Standard (including amendments)
  - (c) Helmets with full face visors, or helmets with goggles, for open vehicles;
  - (d) Fuel restricted to commercial fuel, except for historic vehicles, which may use alcohol fuels in compliance with Supplementary Regulations;
  - (e) External blue triangles (15cm sides) indicating location of battery, or isolation switch:
- Competitors must produce a valid and current AASA Competition Licence or MA equivalent and a Club Membership Card of an AASA Affiliated Car Club or Club Membership Card of a MA affiliated Car Club.
- Track Density will be maximum of 8 Automobiles in each session, but any competitors who prefer smaller groups will be accommodated.
- Each run will be for a maximum 20-minute duration. Any drivers who do not wish to run for 20 minutes can pull into pit lane as they require.
- Groups can be set by the competitors or if required assistance will be given by officials.
- Each Driver must have a race receiver communication from the Clerk of the Course.
- A Course/Safety Car may be used to start, stop, or suspend each session.

# • CLASSES:

- o Class 2 Up to 1600cc
- o Class 3 1601cc to 3000cc
- o Class 4 Over 3000cc
- o Class 5 All Turbo 4WD's
- o Class 6 V8's (If the V8 vehicle is under 4.8lt, they can nominate in class 4)
- Results will be determined by timing system with transponders fitted to all vehicles.

### Awards

 A trophy will be awarded for 1st, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3rd in class and Overall Fastest time of the day

### SCHEDULE/ OTHER EVENT REQUIREMENTS:

- Passenger rides may be permitted by discretion of Clerk of Course.
- Entries will be accepted in order of receipt unless otherwise specified.
- Late entries may be accepted at the Clerk of Course's discretion. A late entry fee of \$50 will be applied.
- Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent/ guardian. Minimum age is 14 years old.
- The Event Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.
- Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.
- Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and "vaping") and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling / defueling operation.
- Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.
- Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
